














She even wears them to the zoo!

One day, Zahra went outside to play and noticed that one of her gloves went missing!






Later that day she said, "Mom, I don't want anyone to see my hands without my gloves."

You can get eczema on your arms, back, belly...






...or just about anywhere on your body!








"Honey, you're not alone in this. Many other kids like yourself and even adults like me have eczema!" said Zahra's mom.
